

LENT SEASON

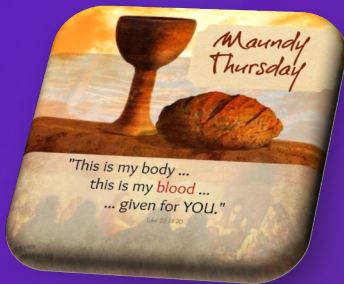
