News from the Council President

At the annual meeting in January, I brought up two important issues for the congregation to understand. The first issue was the significant increase in property insurance and the second was necessary repairs that needed to be made on flashings, soffits and fascia at the church. I'm writing to provide an update on the status of both issues.

I reported in January that the company that had provided the insurance for the church for years, Church Mutual, notified us early last year that they would not be renewing our policy. Our church was not alone. More than 600 churches in Texas and Louisiana were also notified their policies would not be renewed. This was due to Church Mutual characterizing our area as a "catastrophic area", due to various weather impacts. Needless to say, this created a mad scramble for churches to replace their insurance provider. Those who were able to obtain coverage saw significant increases in their premiums. Our church was able to obtain coverage for our property, but the cost was over \$32,000.00, more than double what we had been paying.

Good news to report is that effective June 1, 2025, the church policy will switch to another company. Our annual premium cost will decrease by more than \$14,000.00. The new policy will be through Germania Insurance Company.

The second issue to discuss is the ongoing repairs being made to flashings, soffits and fascia boards around the church exterior. These repairs involved replacing some of the original metal flashings which had corroded, allowing water to seep behind the wood trim at the eave line. This caused damage to wooden soffits and fascia boards. The repairs and replacement of flashing and wood trim are more than 60% complete. We are awaiting delivery of a 60-foot, articulated boom lift to enable us to complete repairs at the upper eaves. Work should be completed by the end of June. Thanks for your patience as we complete these essential repairs.
